Event Featuring Clendenen, Live Entertainment on Sunday, April 13 at Fortuna's River Lodge

An event open to all community members featuring dinner, a silent auction, live music and an opportunity for all to meet and talk to Humboldt County Second District supervisor candidate Clif Clendenen will take place at Fortuna's River Lodge on Sunday, April 13.

Doors open at 2 p.m. to a free open house, including snacks and cider, live music by Falling Rocks with Clendenen joining in to play mandolin, a silent auction and a chance to meet the candidate. The evening event follows immediately at 5 p.m., including a gourmet dinner from Dorris and Daughters Catering, more live music featuring Good Company and the Berel Alexander Ensemble, more auctions, a raffle and Clendenen meeting with and speaking to the guests.

Berel Alexander has been entertaining Northern California audiences since childhood. As a boy soprano he recorded on the Music For Little People label and at 17 was tenor soloist in the California All-State Honor Choir. Berel has performed with RBSyndrome, Mad River Transit and Subliminal Sabotage. The ensemble includes violinist Otis Harriel, who was recently soloist with the Eureka Symphony.

Clendenen was born and raised in the Second District and has for the past 30 years been the owner of his family business Clendenen's Cider Works in Fortuna, and he strongly backs a sustainable economy with responsible use of agricultural and forest lands and supports well-planned, smart growth in the district's towns and communities. He is also an active advocate for the restoration of the Eel and Mattole rivers, with restoration of salmon and steelhead habitats and water flows returned to their natural levels.
